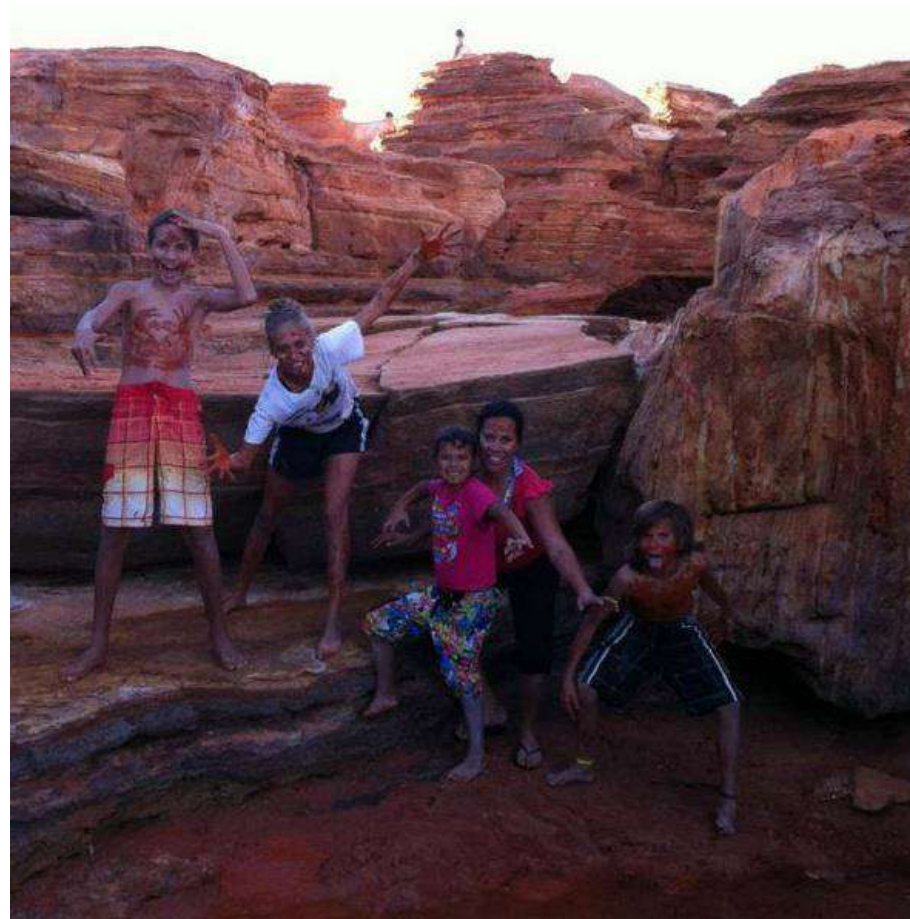

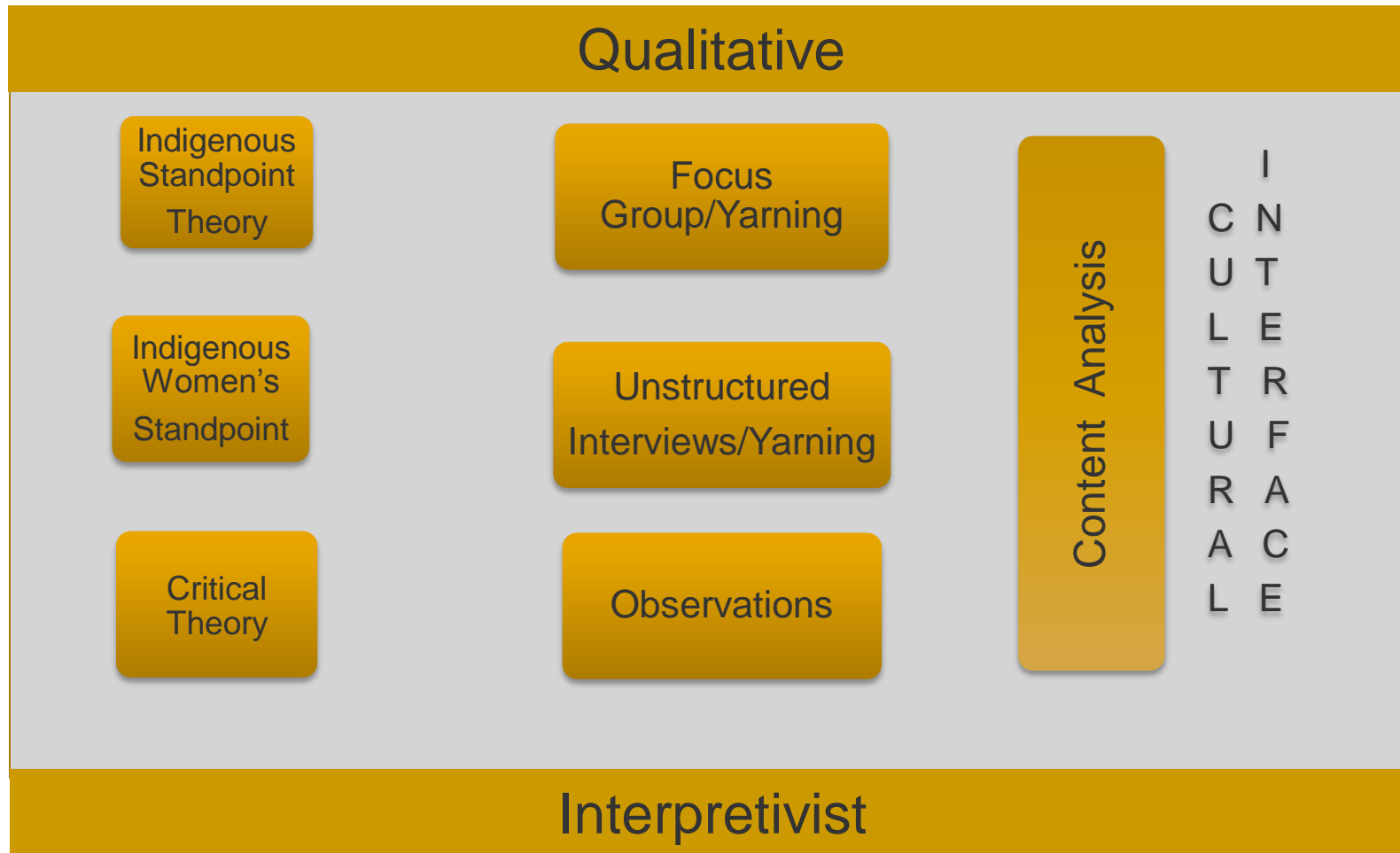


Research Question and Objectives
