




THE EVOLUTION

SIREN STRUCTURE

- Project team 8 part time staff (3.8FTE)
- 1.3FTE base funding per annum; 2.5FTE additional grants
- PhD/Masters students and student volunteers
- Tiered governance structure increases potential for research & evaluation, capacity building, knowledge dissemination, participation & cross-sector collaboration.
